

Information Sheet for the SLO Bytes Listserv

You can set up how you are registered with the SLO Bytes listserv and how you interact with it by pointing your browser to

Clicking on this link will bring up a page that looks like this:

In order to change your membership option, you must first log in by giving your email address and membership password in the section below. If you don't remember your membership password, you can have it emailed to you by clicking on the button below. If you just want to unsubscribe from this list, click on the *Unsubscribe* button and a confirmation message will be sent to you.

Important: From this point on, you must have cookies enabled in your browser, otherwise none of your changes will take effect.

By clicking on the *Unsubscribe* button, a confirmation message will be emailed to you. This message will have a link that you should click on to complete the removal process (you can also confirm by email; see the instructions in the confirmation message).

Password reminder

By clicking on the *Remind* button, your password will be emailed to you.

Do not be alarmed with the annotation **Error: No address given**. In fact, at this point, you haven't inserted your e-mail address.

To change your personal settings, Insert the address where you receive SLO Bytes Listserv announcements in the window immediately to the right of where it says **Email address:**

If you know your password, insert it immediately to the right of where it says **Password:**

If you are unsure of your password or wish to verify it, leave **Password:** blank and click on the button

Doing this will e-mail your current password to the e-mail address by which you are known to the listserv. Open that e-mail and then return to this page and enter the password to the right of where it says and click the button.

The next screen allows you to change your e-mail address, your password, how and how often you receive announcements from the SLO Bytes listserv and several other settings. The page includes context-specific help menus. If you make any changes, you must click the button at the bottom of the page in order for your changes to be made.
